This product is a UCITS Fund [authorised in Luxembourg and regulated by the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier].	This product is not subject to any fixed term.

The Fund aims to deliver returns comparable with the MSCI World (the “Benchmark”) over a rolling 3-year period.

The Fund is actively managed using a quantitative investment strategy and seeks to enhance the returns of the Benchmark by modifying the holdings and the weights of the holdings of the Benchmark for additional return. The strategy integrates sustainability criteria as part of the stock picking process and through a proprietary sustainability assessment.

The Fund invests substantially in shares (equities) listed on international stock exchanges.

The Fund may invest in forward foreign currency exchange contracts, foreign currency swaps and exchange-traded derivatives, for hedging purposes and efficient portfolio management.

You can buy and sell shares on any day that is a business day in Luxembourg, the United Kingdom and the United States of America, and such transactions will be traded on the Fund’s next available valuation date

The fund’s performance should be assessed against its target benchmark being to exceed the MSCI World Index. The fund’s investment universe is expected to overlap materially with the components of the benchmark but does not specifically track the performance of the benchmark and may also hold investments outside of this index.

The MSCI World Index does not take into account the ESG characteristics promoted by the Fund, which are intended to be achieved by the investment process followed by the Investment Manager.

The Strategy’s weighted carbon footprint is at least 30% better than that of the general market index. The Strategy’s weighted waste and water footprint is at least 20% better than that of the general market index. The Strategy’s weighted average ESG score is 10% better than that of the general market index.

What happen if the Manufacturer is unable to pay out?

The Management Company, as the PRIIPs manufacturer, has no obligation to pay out since the product design does not contemplate any such payment being made. However, investors may suffer loss if the Fund or the depositary is unable to pay out. There is no compensation or guarantee scheme in place which may offset, all or any, of this loss.

What are the costs?

Costs over Time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Recommended holding period:	7 Years
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This product has no required minimum holding period but is designed for long-term investment. Since the value of investments can rise and fall over differing time periods, you should have an investment horizon of at least 7 years when buying an investment of this type. The minimum recommended holding period is therefore 7 years. You can request to take out some or all of your money at any time. You can typically request to buy or sell shares in the Fund on any business day (as set out in the Fund's prospectus).
